1. Speech issues like slurred speech and problems getting words out

4. Tremors, body twitches
5. Seizures 2-5% in MS vs. 3% in general population. 70% are focal.
6. Hearing loss 6% of patients due to damage to the hearing nerve pathway.
7. Pruritis, itching caused by damage to nerves in the skin or nerves that send signals from the skin to the brain.
